INTRODUCTION

Craigdhu is situated on the periphery of the south side of Dumfries. The property is nestled off a minor public road.

Craigdhu is of traditional construction set over a single floor and offers spacious three-bedroom family accommodation. To the front of Craigdhu there is a lawned garden and to the side and rear a concrete pad offers parking for several vehicles. A feature of Craigdhu is the grazing paddock, with direct access from the dwelling house and an agricultural shed (50 x 30), which is currently utilised for storage but could be used for many different purposes. There are also two block built lean-to storage sheds

The immediate area offers excellent walking, hiking and cycling routes with the Maiden bower walk, right on the doorstep. There are many attractions of scenic and historical interest within easy reach yet, within a short drive to all town centre amenities and major road networks both north and south.

All services are located within the busy market town of Dumfries, boasting all essential and professional services, along with three retail parks, an ice rink, and a University Campus. Dumfries offers a wide choice of both primary and secondary schooling with the Crichton University Campus offering a wide variety of further education choices.

This area of Southwest Scotland enjoys one of the most varied and picturesque landscapes within Scotland, ranging from the moorland of the Southern Upland Hills to the bays and sandy beaches of the distinctive coastline. This is a rural county where agriculture and tourism thrive to form the backbone of the local economy. The area has been relatively unscathed by modern industry.

The region is well-known for the quality and variety of both field sports and leisure activities with the outdoor and sporting enthusiast extremely well-catered for as there exist the ability to take both shooting and fishing locally. Given the diverse landscape along with the proximity to the coast and local lochs, the area offers unique walks, sailing, cycling and for the golfer there is an abundance of good local courses with the region boasting no fewer than twenty-nine courses.

With two windows to the side and one to the front.

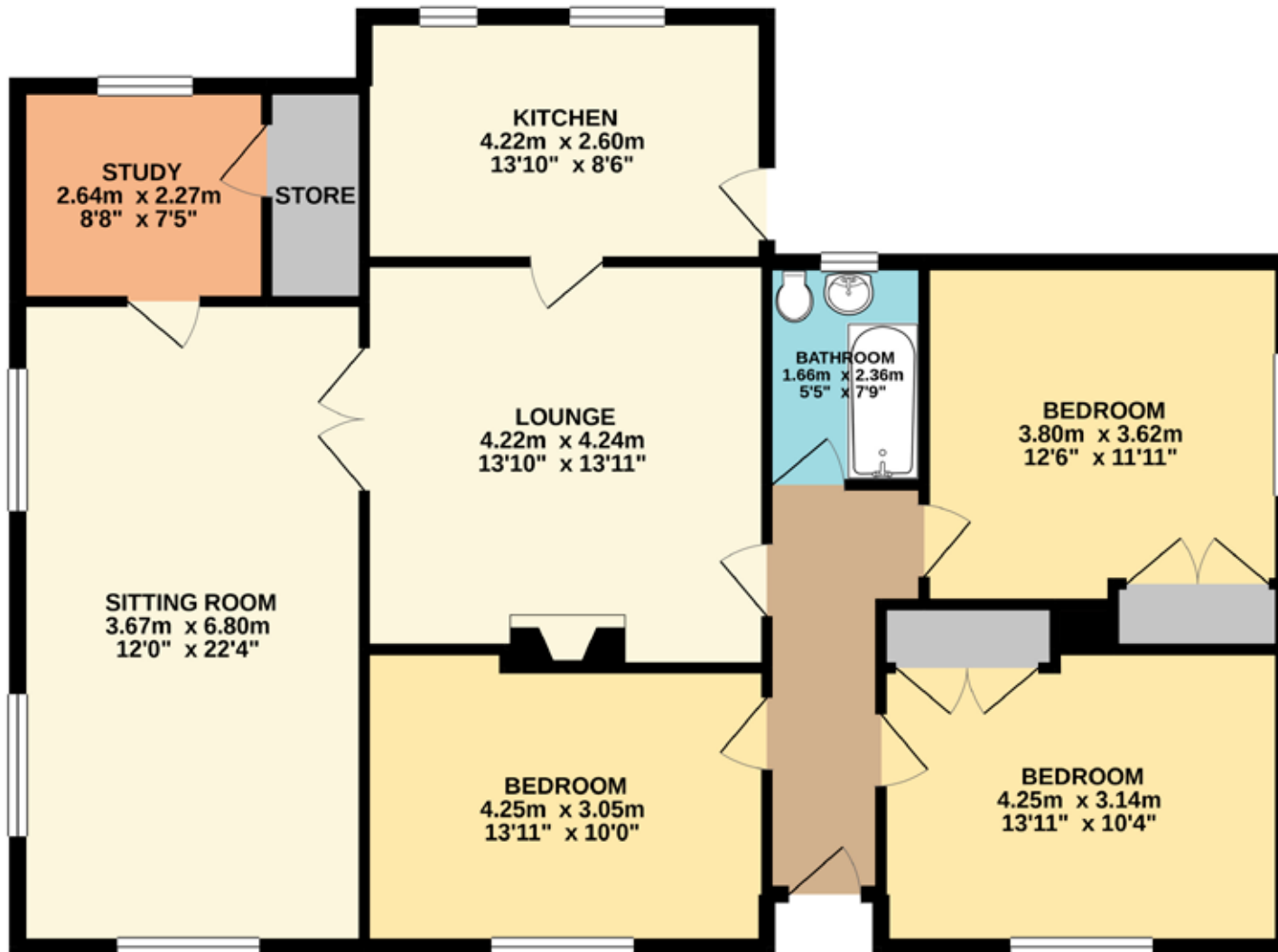


- **Office**

OUTSIDE

As mentioned earlier, there is a concrete driveway leading to the rear of the property where there is parking for several vehicles. An attached lean-to store is to the rear of the house and an agricultural shed (50 x 30) with two block-built lean-to stores off. There is a gated access to the grazing paddock which offers huge potential for small scale agricultural purposes or indeed some self-sufficient living. Located at the edge of the grazing paddock is a poly-tunnel which may be available by separate negotiation.
